H. Old Business:

1. 2nd Reading / Approval of Ordinance # 527 setting standards and regulations for small cell towers.

1. Discussion/Approval of Resolution 19-001 for the mayor to contract with Trane to install LED lighting and energy saving devices and equipment throughout the city owned property and buildings, including wi-fi nodules and additional energy saving and safety technology. This includes electronic water meters and drive-by readers.

Action Taken: Motion made by Motion made by Councilman Martin, second by Vice Mayor Callahan to allow discussion for the Mayor to enter into a contract with Trane.

Discussion: Mayor Holland introduced Rod Goad, the grant writer from Northwest TN Development District. Rob is working on a \$50,000.00 Wi-Fi downtown grant that has the possibility of offsetting some of the cost on the Trane contract. Mayor Holland stated that she felt this Wi-Fi endeavor would be a very beneficial to not only our established businesses, but to entrepreneurs. It is a very competitive grant, so we are not sure we will even get it.

Future action was needed to move to go forth with the authorization to pursue the loan agreement between the City of McKenzie and the Tennessee Municipal bond fund, the resolution states the principal amount will not exceed \$ 2,700,000.00

Action Taken: Motion made by Vice Mayor Callahan, second by Councilperson Pruneau to proceed with the loan agreement.

J. Any Other Business:

Mayor Holland informed the council that when applying for LPRF grants, there is a new requirement called an NLU, which is a Notice of Limitation of Use. This simply says that the city recreational park and Mulberry Park land can only be used for recreational purposes.

Action Taken: Motion made by Councilman Pruneau, second by Councilman Winston that these properties will be deemed NLU properties.
