Job Title: Firefighter

Job Summary:

A firefighter is responsible for responding to emergencies, including fires, accidents, natural disasters, and hazardous material incidents. Firefighters protect life, property, and the environment by performing rescue operations, extinguishing fires, and providing medical assistance. They also participate in fire prevention, public education, and equipment maintenance.

Key Responsibilities:

- Respond quickly and effectively to fire alarms, emergency calls, and rescue situations.
 - Extinguish fires using appropriate firefighting equipment and techniques.
 - Conduct search and rescue operations to locate and assist people in danger.
 - Provide emergency medical care and first aid as a certified EMR or AEMT.
